We are excited to announce that we will continue to participate in the TCS RaiseRight program! By just purchasing items you would have normally purchased anyway, we raised over \$3000 for Trinity and our parent's tuition this past year!!

RaiseRight is just another way to pay for everyday items using gift cards in place of cash, debit cards, and credit cards, and as a bonus you build up rebates to **help pay for your lunch bill and help TCS in their fundraising goals!** Even with the newly established Iowa School Choice program, utilizing RaiseRight for your lunch bill will help with your family's budget! Remember, RaiseRight isn't just for families with kids at Trinity. It's for grandparents, aunts & uncles, community members, friends - for anyone!.

There are nearly 1,000 companies involved in the RaiseRight program already - Walmart 2.5%, Target 2.5%, Kohl's 4%, Menards 3%, Kwik Star 4%, Subway 6%, Lowes 4% & Visa gift card 1.25%, just to name a few.

In addition to the 1,000's of businesses who participate we have local businesses participating too - We will continue with Polashek's Locker at 5%, The Fort at 10% as well as Fareway and HyVee at 3%! If you have a local business connection that you would like to see added please let us know.

For example: I purchase a \$100 gift card through the RaiseRight website for Kwik Star Grocery or a physical card order for The Fort. Both offer a 10% rebate. I get \$10 back - \$5 goes to the school, and the other \$5 goes towards my student's lunch bill.

Fill out your info and you will be set to purchase your cards. Our regular ordering schedule for physical cards during the school year is on the 1st and 3rd Friday of every month and by request.
